Following the third wave of global democratic transformation and political autonomization since representative democracy found its place in 13th-century England, nations from around the world are beginning to emphasize the importance of international exchange. By expanding the scale of foreign collaboration, we can expect to strengthen our diplomatic structures.

In an environment where information is shared across nations, we are able to connect with others globally, as well as freely share our opinions regarding local and foreign affairs outside the political framework established by our experts and bureaucracy.

The most valuable asset of a democratic, autonomous government is its right to seek out the most effective method for political execution. This is especially significant this day and age when capitalism is prominent, as even though capitalism brings economic growth, it inevitably also raises societal challenges, which are best remedied on a case-by-case basis.

As such, Global Councils Forum (GCF) Establishment Initiative serves to set up a standard we, national or regional council assemblies, shall refer to as we continue with our assembly.

1. Any national or regional council assemblies that agree with the mission of the GCF shall be eligible to participate in the GCF.
2. Every participant of the GCF shall be treated equally regardless of racial, complexion, gender, language, or religious differences.
3. Our participants shall be encouraged to share with one another under the spirit of NGO and NPO, to ensure world peace and to benefit all of humanity.
